

NOTICE OF TRANSIT POLICY CHANGES EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2018

Demand Response:

- Automatic age eligibility has been raised to persons aged 65 and older
 - Persons that are currently under 65 years of age and are already qualified and maintain their Demand Response/Paratransit eligibility uninterrupted will be allowed to continue using Demand Response
- General public access to the complementary paratransit system is discontinued
- The name of the service will change from Demand Response to Paratransit

Fixed Route:

- The discount fare is limited to adults 65 (seniors) and over with a government-issued photo ID, TTD Demand Response cardholders, Medicare cardholders with government-issued photo ID, and veterans with a service connected disability (approved card images below) – ONLY – NO EXCEPTIONS



- Medi-Cal and Medicaid cardholders will **no longer** receive a reduced fare
- The youth fare is discontinued; age 4 and under ride free; **ages 5 through 64 ride at full fare**
- The Emerald Bay Shuttle fare is adjusted to \$4.00 per person (\$2.00 reduced fare)

Other Transit Changes:

- Maximum occupied wheelchair lift and ramp capacity is 600 pounds
