I. CALL TO ORDER AND GENERAL MATTERS

A. Roll Call and Determination of Quorum

The meeting of the Committee was called to order by Ms. Hill at 4:13 at the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and via GoToWebinar. Roll call was taken and it was determined a quorum was in attendance for the Committee.

Mr. Fink responded The Ferraro Group will be assisting with the outreach regarding the application and added the thought is to allow for a 30-day window to apply. Mr. Chapman stated his preference is to have three public members with broad community participation, such as a transit user, employer, and a resident. Mr. Davis noted the application looks fine, but suggested revising the last question of the application to ask "What is your experience with public transit in Tahoe?" Mr. Bruce suggested looking at those who have been very engaged in the project. Ms. Hill agreed with the 30-day application period, with a deadline of April 8 at 5:00 p.m. and then schedule the next committee meeting on

April 13 or 20 to review the applications and choose the new members. Ms. Hill noted the applicants must commit to at least eight months of meetings.

Mr. Davis moved to direct staff to move forward with the application and process as discussed in the meeting. Mr. Chapman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Action Requested:

It is requested the committee review the applications received for public member participation and approve three public members to be added to the committee through 2022 for the purpose of the committee acting as a steering group for the TTD site assessment and public outreach process for Incline Village transit.

Fiscal Analysis:

All expenditures associated with this item are accounted for in the FY22 approved budget and included in the draft FY23 budget.

Work Program Analysis:

This project is included in the work program and the TTD's Capital Improvement Program. All work associated with this effort will be captured under respective elements of the existing Work Program and corresponding allotted staff time.

Background:

The Incline Village Mobility Committee will advise staff and the consultant conducting the Site Alternatives Analysis for the Incline Village Mobility Hub on how to best involve and engage the public during the public outreach phase of the analysis. The intent on involving the public in assisting with this guidance is to ensure there is transparency and broad civic engagement.

The committee approved an application form at the last meeting. The forms were distributed to community groups, circulated on social media, uploaded on the inclinevillagemobilityhub.org website and TTD website, and posted around the community. A Spanish language version of the application was also available. To date, Staff have received twelve applications. The closing date for the applications is April 8, 2022 at 5:00 pm. Any additional applications received after the agenda packet is distributed and before the deadline will be distributed as an agenda update.

What makes you a good candidate to be on the Incline Village Mobility Committee?

My husband and I have made a life changing, personal commitment as well as substantial investment to living in Incline/IVCB/Tahoe area. We care! And I have demonstrated interest and ability to work with community members in identifying concerns, understanding implications and working collaboratively and constructively within the community and with staff & elected/appointed officials to raise concerns, gather information and recommend interventions.

What is your knowledge of, or experience in, public engagement, planning, and public transit?

As I have learned about issues facing the community and area, I have made local contacts, learned about history and current initiatives/issues and actively engaged with others in the community to constructively influence outcomes via agency outreach, public input opportunities, etc. In these efforts, I have also liaised with applicable staff to understand available data & suggest supplemental analyses and/or approaches. I believe these efforts have contributed to improved mutual understanding and at times modified/enhanced wording and recommendations.

My specific knowledge/experience re public transit/parking/traffic/transportation/congestion & safety arenas in the local area is well known to Washoe District 1 Commissioners (A. Hill currently and M. Berkbigler previously), TRPA and TTD governing bodies and applicable staff based on discussions related to various transportation planning efforts over recent years.

What do you feel is the most important contribution you can make as a member of the Committee?

I believe that a TQM type of data-driven approach is critical to effectively address the above mentioned transportation issues and impacts on safety and environment in the already very congested Incline Village area. From my perspective several recent interventions, while well-intentioned, have often added concerns rather than assuring definitive, lasting positive impact. My background in using TQM approaches to develop and implement lasting, positive operational and programmatic intervention is directly applicable to the parking, traffic, transportation and mobility issues being addressed here. Also, I hope that my record of providing well researched feedback, logical recommendations and positively engaging fellow community members will be helpful.

What is your experience, specifically, with public transit in Tahoe?

I believe that I have addressed this in summary above. Some specific examples include:

- Support for the micro-transit pilot last summer but also flagging gaps created initially by failure to service Sand Harbor and also by continued artificial barriers to providing service across county lines
- Identification that public roadside paths were often not plowed in winter & unsafe for personal transit
- Flagged failure of TART lines to service Sand Harbor area creating lack of usage by incoming NLT/CA area folks unwilling to change in IV to a second transit vehicle for the short remaining trip to East Shore thus resulting in added vehicles unnecessarily brought into the congested IV area.
- Surfaced still incompletely addressed issues of influx from Carson/SLT area which should be remedied by intercepts at the southern access to the East Shore recreation areas. And pilot results/similar issues remain to be definitively addressed for traffic from Reno area
- Raised concerns re traffic, vehicles, congestion re safety on narrow streets/neighborhoods daily and more so should evacuation be needed
- Emphasized lack of a Capacity Management program for the East Shore recreation areas which has been a priority implementation component in other tourist destination areas in the US and abroad
- Raised concerns re need for accurate, current statistical data to drive program planning for positive outcomes
